Situation

Situated on the edge of the village of Burghill which can be located north west of Hereford city. The village itself has a primary school and popular golf course with further amenities nearby in Tillington having village stores and superb public house - The Bell Inn. Hereford city is only a short drive away (Approximately 4.5 miles) which offers an excellent range of amenities to include leisure centre, racecourse, restaurants, shopping and cinema.

Description

Great attention to detail can be found throughout this stunning home, such as the bespoke Kitchen/Breakfast Room and Dressing Room.

The property is accessed via a private gravel driveway ending in a sweep in front of the property.

From the Hall is access into the Dining Room, and Garden Room having a Clearview wood burning stove and bay window overlooking the gardens.

The rear Hall offers access into the Utility Room with marble top, fitted sink and cupboards and housing the combination boiler.

The Kitchen/Breakfast Room is over two levels with tiled flooring, extensive handmade floor and wall units, ample marble worktops with fitted sink, dishwasher, Rangemaster double oven and under the breakfast bar is a fitted steam oven/microwave and built in fridge freezer. No detail has been missed.

The Sitting Room offers oak flooring with a Clearview wood burning stove and bread oven to one side. Beyond this is a cloakroom with WC and wash hand basin.

The Drawing Room has oak flooring and features a further Clearview wood burning stove with double doors leading into the stunning Victorian style Conservatory with added underfloor heating.

The main staircase is located in the front Hall and leads up to the top landing where there are two bedrooms, each with Victorian fire grates. The Family Bathroom has a bath, shower cubicle, WC and wash hand basin. Along the hall are hanging cupboards and a handy airing cupboard.

The Master Bedroom has its own Bathroom with shower cubicle, bath and wash hand basin. The Dressing Room has Hammond built in wardrobes and a door leading onto the balcony with wonderful views over the gardens and grounds of the property.

There are two further bedrooms, one being the main guest bedroom with its own bathroom with built in wardrobes, dressing table and underfloor heating.

Outside, the gardens form a real feature of the property offering a scope of impressive attributes. There is a summer house, previous tennis lawn, separate WC and an abundance of shrubs, trees and lit paths, together with ornamental ponds.

A large paved terrace makes an excellent entertaining space and above the property are hedged and fenced paddocks with field shelters and a vegetable garden. There are four stables with concrete yarding and a machinery shed.

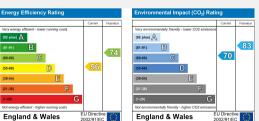


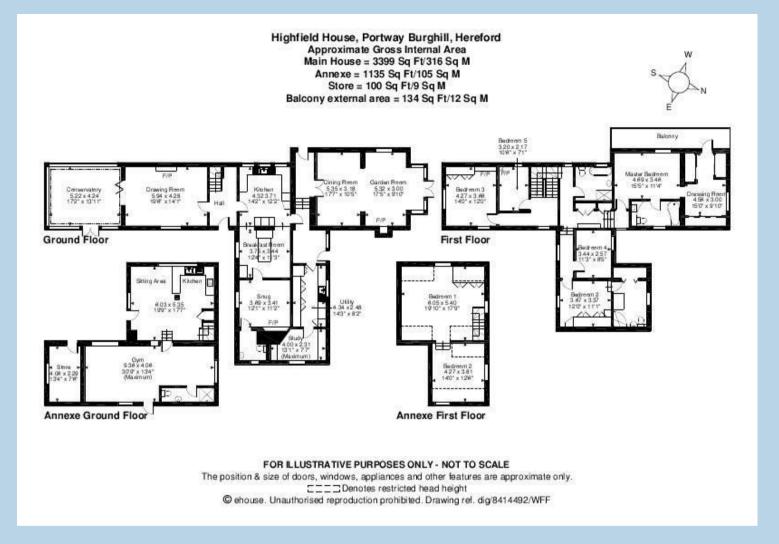
